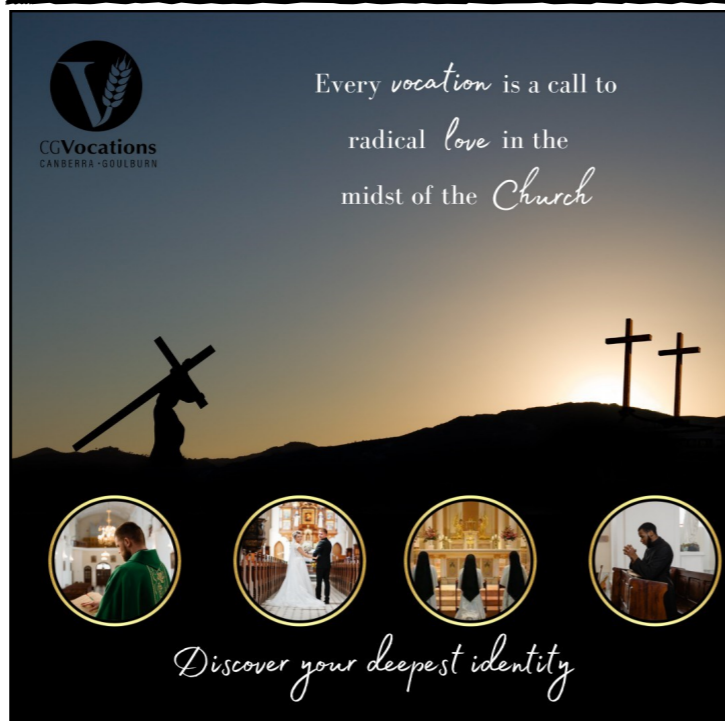

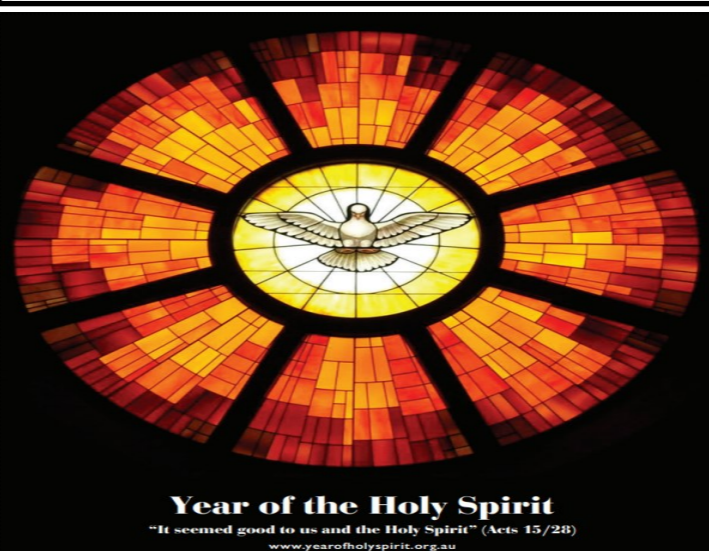
CHURCH OPENING HOURS
