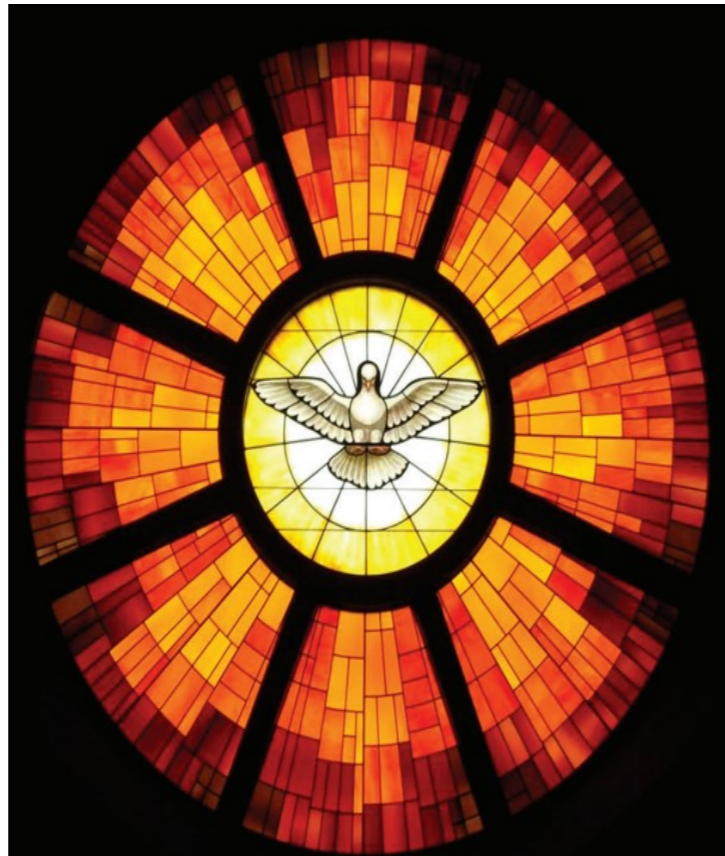

What is Lent?

Lent is a liturgical season that marks the preparation of the Church for Easter. It emphasizes the practices of prayer, almsgiving and fasting, alongside meditation on the Word of God, conversion and reconciliation.

4 keys

Begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on the evening of Holy Thursday.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday we practice fasting and abstinence.

The 3 Lenten practices are prayer, penance and charity.

The liturgical color of this season is purple, which symbolizes penitence.
