Lent is a **liturgical season** that marks the preparation of the Church for Easter. It emphasizes the practices of **prayer**, **almsgiving and fasting**, alongside meditation on the Word of God, conversion and **reconciliation**.

Begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on the evening of Holy Thursday.

The 3 Lenten practices are prayer, penance and charity. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday we practice fasting and abstinence.

The **liturgical color** of this season is **purple**, which symbolizes **penitence**.
