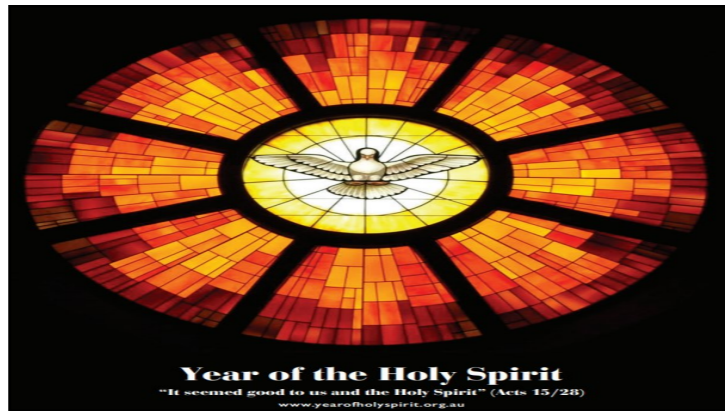

COMMUNITY FAREWELL FOR SR MARY CORKERON

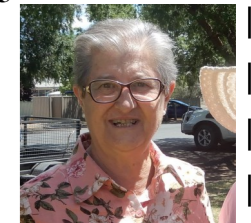
Monday, 3rd June from 3.00pm to 5.00pm at Grenfell Bowling Club.
