Catholics are insisting that their Church recognise the equality of women. Catholics throughout Australia have expressed shock at their bishops' failure to support a positive statement about women's equality in the Catholic Church at the Australian Plenary Council on 6 July.

'Pope Francis is committed to a Church that listens to the people of God. At the very least, the bishops have a responsibility to inform the Holy See of the views of Australian Catholics, the sense of faith of the faithful.'
