**SOCIAL JUSTICE SUNDAY
 24th SEPTEMBER**

This year's Social Justice Statement from Australia's bishops considers the nation's economic priorities. Everyone's Business: Developing an inclusive and sustainable economy will be launched this month. Produced by the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference, it draws from the teachings of Pope Francis and his predecessors to highlight how the exclusion of poor and vulnerable citizens from the benefits of economic growth, reveals a lack of justice in the economic system itself. The statement calls for a new approach that prevents exclusion from the outset and engages all people as dignified contributions to sustainable and economic growth.
