WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY – SUNDAY 24 JULY 2022

The second "World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly" is marked on *Sunday July 24*. In 2021 Pope Francis announced this day to take place on the fourth Sunday in July, each year; a date chosen because of its proximity to the feast day of S. Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.

In 2022 message, Pope Francis invited grandparents and the elderly to join a "spiritual and non-violent revolution." He urged seniors not to despair at their frailty but to embrace "a new mission" of caring for others in a world torn apart by conflict.

"Old age is no time to give up and lower the sails, but a season of enduring fruitfulness: a new mission awaits us and bids us look to the future".

"The special sensibility that those of us who are elderly have for the concerns, thoughts, and the affections that make us human should once again become the vocation of many. It would be a sign of our love for the younger generations.'
