FEAST OF THE ANNUNCIATION

On Monday 9th April we celebrate the Annunciation of the Lord. Usually the Feast is celebrated on 25th March, because the Feast Day fell in Holy Week it is transferred to the first suitable day during Eastertide.
 The Feast of the Annunciation commemorates the visit of the archangel Gabriel to the Virgin Mary, during which he informed her that she would be the mother of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.
 The "angelic salutation" of Gabriel to Mary, "Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with thee", and Mary's response to God's will, "be it done to me according to thy word". The angelic salutation" is the origin of the Hail Mary prayer and the Angelus.
