 She lives with her husband, Masud, in rural Bangladesh, where maternal and infant mortality rates are tragically high.  
 Thankfully, Salma was helped through her pregnancy by a Caritas trained midwife called Pronoti. The Safe Motherhood program has now reduced the area's maternal and infant mortality by almost 70 percent.
