**FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD TUESDAY 6<sup>th</sup> AUGUST**

The transfiguration of Jesus provides a glimpse of Jesus Christ's deity. This revelation of His glory is recorded in The Synoptic Gospels, Matthew, Mark and Luke.  
 One week before the transfiguration, Peter shared his confession of Jesus as Messiah. Jesus would soon make His final departure from Galilee.  
 One of the purposes of the Transfiguration was to strengthen the faith of the disciples in the divine nature of Jesus before they experienced the shock of the difficult days ahead.  
 Jesus longed for a presentation of His Heavenly Father's divine magnificence and splendour in human form.
