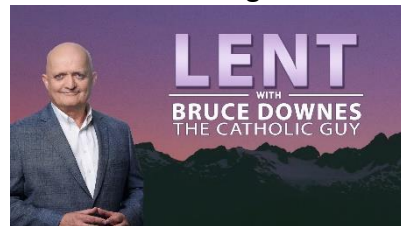

The Harvest Festival

The Harvest Festival has been re-introduced after a hiatus period and the first of the festivals will occur next Sunday.

The Anglicans have a church, St Paul's at Nangus, which had traditionally been well supported by that Community. That support has waned considerably in recent years to the extent that it was proposed to close the Church (which for many years had been financially supported by an annual harvest festival). The imminence of closure caused the Nangus community to reflect on the importance of the Church to them (not only for Baptisms and Funerals but as part of their everyday life).
