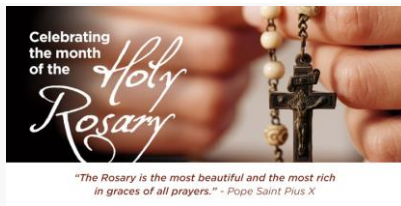

The Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi – 4 October

St. Francis cared for the poor and the sick. He preached sermons to animals and praised all creatures as brothers and sisters under God. He was a mystic Italian Catholic friar, founder of the Franciscans and one of the most venerated figures in Christianity. In 1223, he arranged for the first Christmas live nativity scene.
