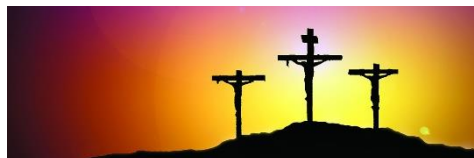

Prayer, Praise and Fellowship

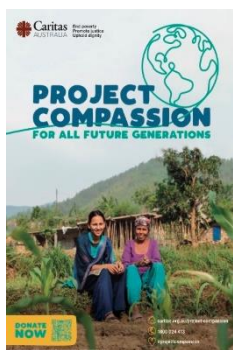
All welcome to come to Immaculate Conception Tumut and join for morning tea (please bring a plate to share). At 12pm we will have Prayer and Praise in the parish hall.
