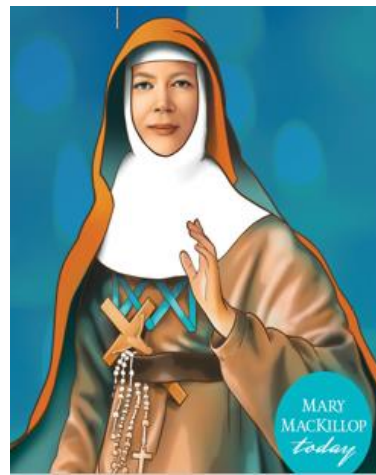
What is a Jubilee? "Jubilee" is the name given to a particular year. A time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of Creation.
