### MAY DEVOTION – BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

May 13<sup>th</sup>, 1917, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to 3 Portuguese children in the small town of Fatima. She appeared six times and identified Herself as “Our Lady of the Rosary”, asking that they pray the rosary daily for the conversion of sinners. Mary also spoke of observing first Saturdays, devotion to her Immaculate Heart and the conversion of Russia. During the final apparition on October 13<sup>th</sup> 1917, the miracle of the sun took place in front of 70,000 people.
