## **Fr Neville Drinkwater Funeral Arrangements**

The Funeral Mass for the late Fr Neville Drinkwater OAM will be celebrated 11am on Tuesday 7 February 2023 at St Thomas Aquinas Church, Lhotsky Street, Charnwood ACT. Following the Mass, Fr Neville will be buried at Woden cemetery.

Fr Neville Drinkwater received a Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) in the Queen's Birthday honours for his service to the Catholic Church in Australia (2016). He is the longest-serving priest in the Archdiocese, ordained in 1954. He was appointed to his first parish in Queanbeyan, and then moved to **Gundagai/Bega** (1955-58), Gunning, and Boorowa then sent to Charnwood to establish St Thomas Aquinas parish in 1974.
