### CHURCH NUMBERS - SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIRED

As you are aware, the current meeting restrictions for places of worship require 4sqm per person. This means that for St Patrick's church we can have **58 people** (not including clergy and servers).

Immediate family may sit together, but parishioners must maintain the required **1.5m physical distance**. The choir loft should be utilised (no more than 8 people) if there is not adequate space to allow this distance in the church pews.

Please do not gather in the aisles or doorway, and give people space to enter and exit the church while maintaining appropriate distance. Remember to sanitise your hands on entry and exit.

Do not attend Mass if you are feeling unwell.

With new cases of Coronavirus being diagnosed, we must remain vigilant in our protocols. Thank you for your cooperation in this effort.
