COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

SIGN-IN & COLLECTIONS: Sign-in on entrance, collection box at church entrance with separate slots for the first and second collection.

SINGING: Congregational singing is to be avoided. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

COMMUNION: is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is not mandatory but is highly recommended, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.

CLEANING: Please use the wipes provided, to clean surfaces of your pew and dispose in the bins provided as you exit.
