

## THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - 22 AUGUST



In the monarchy of King David, the mother of the ruling king held an important office in the royal court. In fact, the king's *mother* ruled as queen, not his wife.

Almost every time the narrative of 1 and 2 Kings introduces a new monarch in Judah, it mentiones the kings' mother as well, showing the mother's intimate involvement in her royal son's reign. Her royal office is also described by the prophet Jeremiah, who tells how the queen mother possessed a throne and a crown, symbolic of her position of authority in the

kingdom. Compare the humble attitude of Bathsheba as spouse of King David – as spouse of the king, she bows with her face to the ground and does obediance to her husband. In striking contrast, after her son, Solomon, assumed the throne, Bathsheba receives a glorious reception upon meeting with her royal son...and he bows down to her!

With this background we can now more clearly see how the New Testament portrays Mary in the everlasting Kingdom of God, none more clearly than the description of the woman in Revelation 12, crowned and mother of the ruler of the nations. Just like the queen mother of the Davidic kingdom, Mary serves as advocate for the people in the Kingdom of God today. We should always approach her with confidence that she will intercede for us to her Son, the King!

#### COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

**COMMUNION:** is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left. Please **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn.

**FACE MASKS**: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.
