Sanitising wipes have been ordered (yet to arrive), packets of wipes will be placed in each occupiable pew and it will be all parishioners responsibility to wipe any surfaces they come into contact with when they visit the church for Mass or private prayer. Bins will be provided

at the back of the church. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter, it is important we each do our part to keep the church clean, and the people within it safe.

FIRST RECONCILIATION

Please keep the parish children, parents and coordinators in your prayers as they commence preparations for the Sacrament of Reconciliation this week. COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

COMMUNION: is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left. Please **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.
