SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY



The Catholic Church in Australia marks Safeguarding Sunday (formerly Child Protection Sunday) on the second Sunday of September – at the conclusion of National Child Protection Week. Safeguarding Sunday seeks to acknowledge the immense damage caused by the sexual abuse of children and adults at risk, including by priests, religious and lay people within Catholic contexts. It makes a commitment to practices and protocols that create and maintain safe environments for all people. It invites people to pray for those harmed by abuse directly and indirectly.

A reminder to all volunteers within the parish, it is a legal requirement that you have a current Working With Children Check if you have direct contact with children, vulnerable people, and if you represent the parish by visiting people in their homes (eg Home Communion), all volunteers

EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS / MEMORIAL OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

Tuesday 14th September Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and Wednesday 15th Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows. The pairing of these celebrations, even in their different levels on the liturgical and sanctoral calendars, properly guides us in our levels of devotion and love of our Savior and Our Lady.
