FRATELLI TUTTI

On Sunday October 4, Pope Francis published his third encyclical letter, Fratelli Tutti (Brothers and Sisters All).

The encyclical has the subtitle of "on fraternity and social friendship". In the encyclical, the Pope states that the COVID-19 pandemic has proven the failure of the world to work together during the crisis. The encyclical calls for more human fraternity and solidarity, and is a plea to reject wars.

Pope Francis reflects upon the parable of the Good Samaritan; this reflection is the theological core of the encyclical. Pope Francis says this parable is an "ever new" call from Jesus to "rediscover our vocation as citizens of our respective nations and of the entire world, builders of a new social bond"

Next weekend, we welcome back to St Patrick's Fr Daniel Benedetti who will celebrate Mass with us on 17th October. Fr Daniel will be staying with Frs George and Namora for a few days in Tumut and kindly offered to celebrate Mass during his visit.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

COLLECTIONS: Please deposit your offerings in the collection box provided at the sign-in table, there are separate slots for the first and second collection.

SINGING: Please note that according to the COVID-19 Safety Plan for Places of Worship developed by NSW Health congregational singing is to be **avoided** and solo singers are to maintain at least 3m physical distance. Singing with facemasks is not a current alternative. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

COMMUNION: is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left. Organ side pews first, middle rows second, pulpit side last. Please **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.

CLEANING: Please wipe any surfaces you come into contact with, with the wipes provided, when you visit the church for Mass or private prayer and dispose in the bins provided as you exit.
