SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI



At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ. The secondary focus of this feast is upon the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with his disciples. He expresses this in the gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep in focus both the unity and the diversity of the Church.
