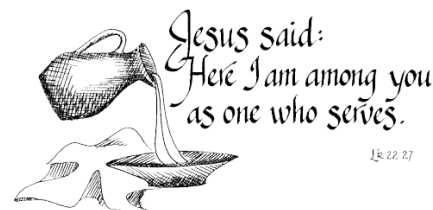
### ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER SUNDAY 4 JULY
