NATIONAL MEN'S CONFERENCE 15 AUGUST

Ask any church statistician and they'll tell you that the most rapidly diminishing demographic in the Church is young men. Males between 25-45 make up the smallest percentage of churchgoers, which shouldn't come as a surprise to most people who regularly attend Mass.

The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) has responded to this crisis by throwing their support behind a national men's conference next month, organised by MenALIVE.



Divided into four sessions comprising talks, prayers and discussions, the ACBC National Catholic Men's Gathering will address the demographic crisis, men's unique role in the life and mission of the Church as well as the role men have played since its inception. COVID-19 PROTOCOLS - RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND

"The sensitive issue of asking all members of the faithful to receive Holy Communion in the hand – and not on the tongue – is in accord with sound reason, unity in our communities and the good of the faithful – in this case their physical health.

Given the living tradition of the Church, which highlights the most ancient practice of receiving Holy Communion in the hand, the Archbishop has the authority to instruct the faithful to receive Holy Communion in the hand during this time of Pandemic, with no exceptions.
