### NATIONAL VOCATIONS AWARENESS WEEK 2-9 AUGUST



National Vocations Awareness Week - This week we celebrated the Feast of St Mary of the Cross McKillop. Our first Australian born canonised saint. St Mary took bold new directions in education and care of children. We know her saying 'Never see a need without doing something about it'. We pray this week that many young people in our communities may embrace this spirit in response to the call of the Lord to serve as priests or consecrated religious.

### COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Please come for Communion from the **RIGHT** aisle only (as you are facing the altar), receive Communion from Fr and the Acolyte in an alternate fashion, and then return to your seats via the **LEFT** aisle only (pulpit side).

PLEASE **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn. This new procedure will take time and patience to perfect. There is no rush, take this time to pray and reflect on the Eucharist.

### FACE MASKS

The NSW Government is strongly encouraging greater use of masks in high-risk public settings, including attendance at religious gatherings, to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Wearing a mask in any of these settings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.
