Please keep the parish children and their families in your prayers as they prepare to receive their First Holy Communion. The First Holy Communion Mass will be celebrated on Saturday 7th November.

MASS FOR ALL SOULS 2 NOVEMBER

All Souls Day Mass will be held in Gundagai on **Monday 2 November at 12noon**, Adelong at 12noon, Tumut at 8am and Batlow at 10am.

Parishioners are encouraged to offer a Mass using the November Masses envelopes at the church entrance.

We can help the Poor Souls in Purgatory in many ways, all of which involve prayer and sacrifice. You can have Masses said for the Poor Souls, or a deceased friend or relative. For a small stipend (eg \$5), you can reserve dates on which the Masses will be offered especially for the souls in Purgatory.

In addition we can offer our attendance at Mass (and one's reception of Holy Communion) for them. We can bring our own petitions to the Lord during the prayers of the faithful but more importantly, at the very moment of His greatest act of love, the consecration. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the Mercy of God, rest in peace.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

COLLECTIONS: Please deposit your offerings in the collection box provided at the sign-in table, there are separate slots for the first and second collection.

SINGING: Please note that according to the COVID-19 Safety Plan for Places of Worship developed by NSW Health congregational singing is to be **avoided** and solo singers are to maintain at least 3m physical distance. Singing with facemasks is not a current alternative. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

COMMUNION: is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left. Organ side pews first, middle rows second, pulpit side last. Please **give 1.5m distance between people**, and remain seated until your turn.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is **not mandatory but is highly recommended**, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.

CLEANING: Please wipe any surfaces you come into contact with, with the wipes provided, when you visit the church for Mass or private prayer and dispose in the bins provided as you exit.
