#### **COVID-19 PROTOCOLS**

SIGN-IN & COLLECTIONS: Sign-in on entrance, collection box at church entrance with separate slots for the first and second collection.

SINGING: Congregational singing is to be avoided. Solo singers, or pre-recorded singing is allowed.

**COMMUNION:** is distributed in an anti-clockwise cycle (as you are facing the altar), up the right hand aisle and return via the left.

FACE MASKS: Wearing a mask in religious gatherings is not mandatory but is highly recommended, especially in areas where there has been community transmission.

**CLEANING:** Please wipe any surfaces you come into contact with, with the wipes provided, when you visit the church for Mass or private prayer and dispose in the bins provided as you exit.
