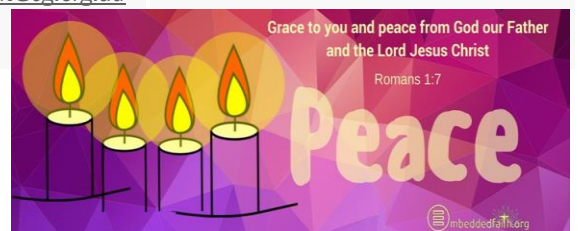

TALBINGO CAROL EVENING

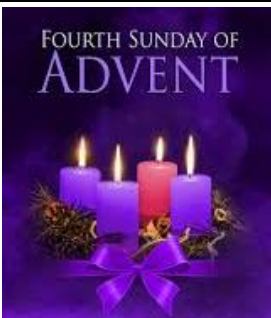
