# SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD

Pope Francis has instituted the Sunday of the Word of God, to be celebrated on the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time each year. The inaugural Sunday of the Word of God will therefore take place on Sunday 26 January, 2020. Pope Francis asks us to mark this Sunday with a certain solemnity, and to 'celebrate, study, and disseminate' the word of God," for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and to break bread in the community of believers." If anyone should hear his voice and open for him, he will come in and eat with them (cf. 3:20). Christ Jesus is knocking at our door in the words of sacred Scripture.
