CORONAVIRUS - PROTOCOLS

- Sunday obligation is suspended at this time, but the faithful are *encouraged* to come to Mass, within government guidelines (under 100 persons), to pray and intercede for the nation.
- Faithful over the age of 75 are *recommended* not to attend Mass.
- DO NOT attend Mass if you suffer fever, cough, fatigue, shortness of breath and/or sore throat.
- No communion to the sick in hospital/aged care.
- Visits to the sick/elderly in private homes only if they are not in isolation.
- Visits to hospitals/aged care discouraged except for immediate family.
- Funerals/Weddings/Baptisms not to exceed 100 persons.
- Seat 1.5m apart except immediate family.
- Collections to be counted with gloves within 24 hours.
- Holy Communion in the hand ONLY.
- No touching at the Sign of Peace.
- Holy Water fonts emptied.
- First Rite of Penance to be conducted in the confessional, or 1.5m away. Penitents under 18 to have door remain open.
- Second Rite of Penance suspended.
- First Penance, First Holy Communion & Confirmation suspended until further notice.
