### CASE WORKER WANTED FOR RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION CENTRE

Case worker required for an exciting new role to help in the development of a Therapeutic Community for women located at Galong. The role will initially involve approximately four hours face to face case management per week. Contract rate: Negotiable subject to qualifications and experience - contract role.
