CASE WORKER WANTED FOR RESIDENTIAL REHABILITATION CENTRE

Case worker required for an exciting new role to help in the development of a Therapeutic Community for women located at Galong. IN ADDITION - All Parish volunteers, regardless of whether they work with children, are to read the Archdiocesan Child Protection Code of Conduct, then sign and return the acknowledgment form.

This should be done **as soon as possible**.
