Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/
Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be
celebrated respecting the new 4sqm per person rule
(excluding clergy and liturgical ministries).

Communion in the hand only.

Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.

No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes
placed at collection points. (Before or after Mass)

MASS ATTENDANCE (4sqm per person rule)

The new 4sqm per person rule will take place in all churches from
1st July, 2020 (excluding clergy and liturgical ministry).

There is no need to book in for masses now, but you still need to
record your name and number in the register provided.

Everyone will need to use hand sanitiser when entering and exiting
the church (provided), plus wipe your pew down after use with the
wipes (provided).

Collection boxes will be located on the steps of the Altar, near the
Offertory table and near the Baptism Font.
(Please come forward after the Homily in orderly fashion).

Those who have restrictions from their Doctor are not to attend
mass, but you are invited to ring and leave your name and number
at the office (on 6382-2222) and either Fr James or Fr Praveen will
visit you at a time that suits you best.
