**CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION
RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)**

(Latest protocols for NSW parishes, effective FRI. 31 JUL 20)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/
Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be
celebrated respecting the new 4sqm per person rule (100
PEOPLE LIMIT) excluding clergy and liturgical ministries.

You need to record your name and number in the register
provided. This way we will have a contact if a health risk is
posed within our community in relation to COVID-19.

Everyone will need to use hand sanitiser when entering and
exiting the church (provided), plus wipe your pew down after
use with the wipes (provided) after the Priest exits.

Communion in the hand only.
Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.

No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes
placed at collection points. (Before or after Mass)

Those who have restrictions from their Doctor are not to
attend mass, but you are invited to ring and leave your name
and number at the office (on 6382-2222) and either Fr James
or Fr Praveen will visit you at a time that suits you best.

PLANNED GIVING ENVELOPES

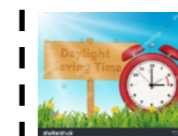
Planned Giving Envelopes for the new financial year is
