# CATHOLIC DIOCESAN PROTOCOLS-YOUNG MISSION RE: THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

(Latest protocols for NSW parishes, effective MON, 7 DEC, 20)

Weekday Masses/Weekend Masses/Weddings/Funerals/ Baptisms/Private Prayer and Social Gatherings are all to be celebrated respecting the 2sqm per person rule (200 people maximum for Masses only), inside excluding clergy and liturgical ministries.

Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/ families apply 2m<sup>2</sup> rule.

You need to record your name and number in the register provided. This way we will have a contact if a health risk is posed within our community in relation to COVID-19.

Everyone will need to use hand sanitiser when entering and exiting the church (provided), plus wipe your pew down after use with the wipes (provided) after the Priest exits.

Communion in the hand only. Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered. No touching at the sign of peace.

No collection plates/bags are to be used, but money/envelopes placed at collection points. (Before or after Mass)

Those who have restrictions from their Doctor are not to attend mass, but you are invited to ring and leave your name and number at Young office (on 6382-2222) and either Fr Jiss or Fr Joe will visit you at a time that suits you best.
