We have received a generous donation of two dressed lambs and we will have 8 prizes of similar value for some lucky winners.

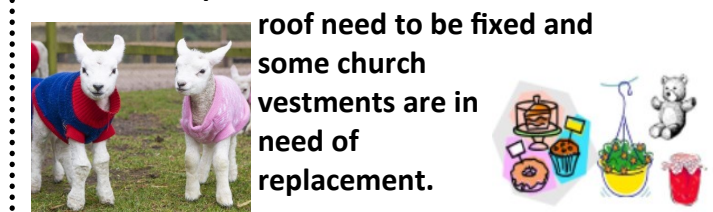
