(It has been decided that Anointing Masses will occur on the 2nd Friday of each month from September onwards)

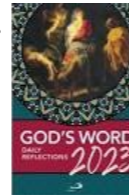

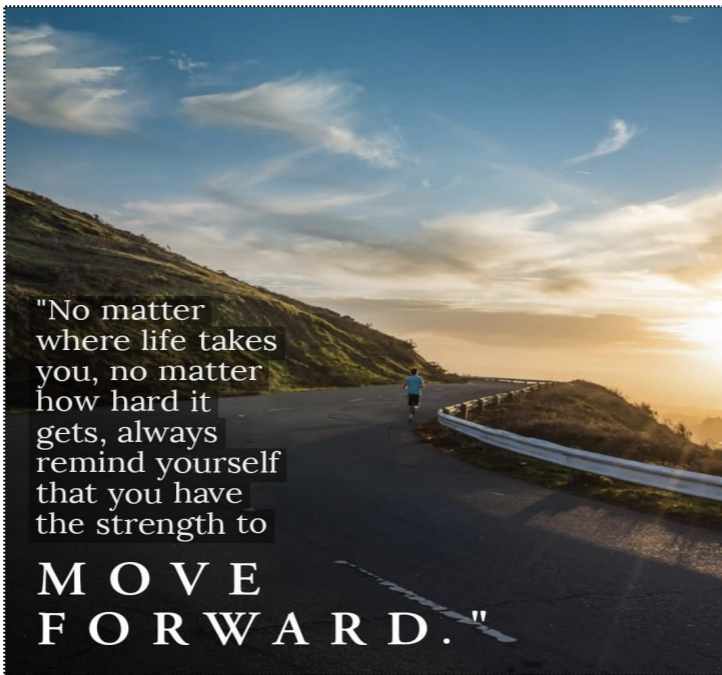
God's Word '23: Daily Reflections Liturgical Diary
