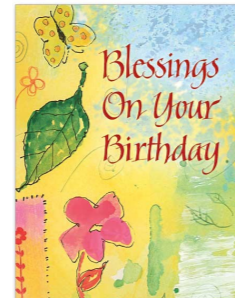

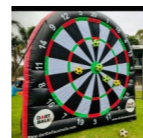
NEXT ANOINTING MASS
