The Parish is planning to start Children's Liturgy again during Saturday night Mass.

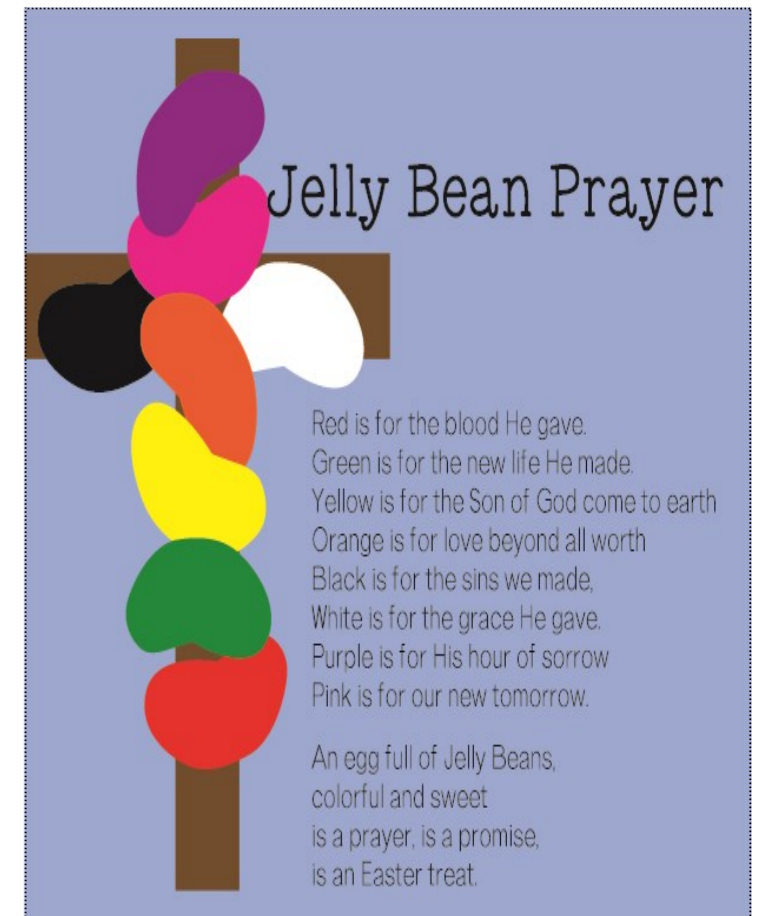
If anyone is interested in helping out in this great ministry during the faith formation of our younger generation, please ring or email the Parish office with your details.
