The next Anointing Mass will be held on Friday, 12th May at the new time of **12-45pm** in St Mary's Church, so Hennessy College students can join in.

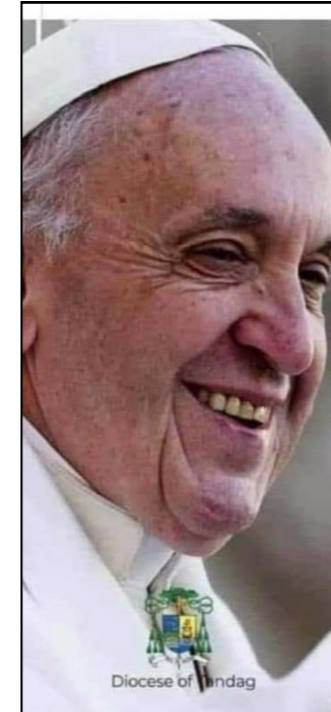
Anointing Masses will occur in Young on the 2nd Friday of each month.
