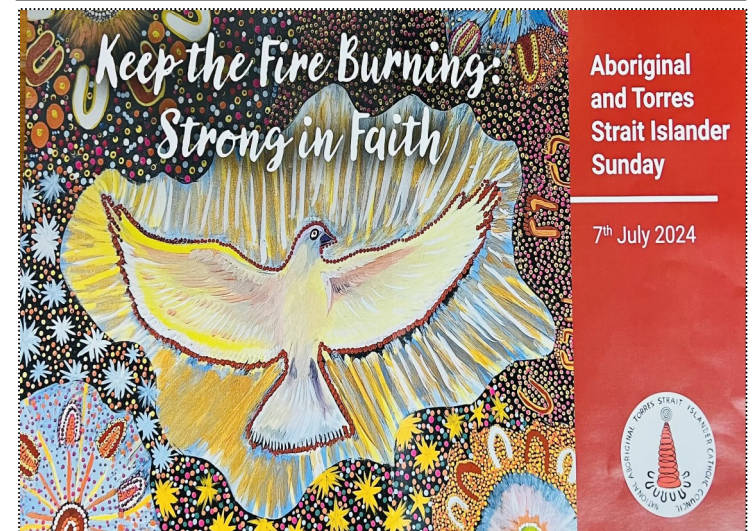
Support: We are seeking resources to help with this project, whether it be manpower or finding people that may be able to help. Your support, in any form, will be greatly appreciated.
