



Your children are as the shoots of an olive tree




. he Gospel goes on to remind us that children are not the property of a family, but have their own lives to lead. Jesus is a model of obe-dience to his earthly parents, placing himself un-der their charge (cf. Lk 2:51), but he also shows that children's life decisions and their Christian vocation may demand a parting for the sake of the Kingdom of God (cf. Mt 10:34-37; Lk 9:59-62). Jesus himself, at twelve years of age, tells Mary and Joseph that he has a greater mission to accomplish apart from his earthly family (cf. Lk 2:48-50). In this way, he shows the need for other, deeper bonds even within the family: "My mother and my brethren are those who hear the word of God and do it" (Lk 8:21). All the same, in the concern he shows for children - whom the societies of the ancient Near East viewed as subjects without particular rights and even as family property - Jesus goes so far as to present them as teachers, on account of their simple trust and spontaneity towards others. "Truly I say to you, unless you turn and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Whoev-er humbles himself like this child, he is the great-est in the kingdom of heaven" (Mt 18:3-4).


