





I must also say that the Synod process proved both impressive and illumina ng. I am grateful for the many contribu ons that helped me to appreciate more fully the problems faced by families throughout the world. The various interven ons of the Synod Fathers, to which I paid close heed, made up, as it were, a mul facet-ed gem reflec ng many legi mate concerns and honest ques ons. For this reason, I thought it appropriate to prepare a post-synodal Apostolic Exhorta on to gather the contribu ons of the two recent Synods on the family, while adding other considera ons as an aid to reflec on, di-alogue and pastoral prac ce, and as a help and encouragement to families in their daily commit-ments and challenges.

This Exhorta on is especially mely in this Jubilee Year of Mercy. First, because it represents an invita on to Chris an families to value the gi s of marriage and the family, and to persevere in a love strengthened by the virtues of generosity, commitment, fidelity and pa ence. Second, be-cause it seeks to encourage everyone to be a sign of mercy and closeness wherever family life re-mains imperfect or lacks peace and joy.




