

Contrary to those who rejected marriage as evil, the New Testament teaches that "everything created by God is good and nothing is to be rejected" (1 Tim 4:4). Marriage is "a gift" from the Lord (° Cor 7:7). At the same time, precisely because of this positive understanding, the New Testament strongly emphasizes the need to safeguard God's gift: "Let marriage be held in honour among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled" (Heb 57:8). This divine gift includes sexuality: "Do not refuse one another" (1 Cor 7:5).
