The foreigner in Israel, the pagans mentioned in Paul's letter to the Romans, and the Canaanite woman in the Gospel were all seen as outsiders by the Jewish people. Yet, the readings stress that all are accepted by God if we choose to follow God's law, repent and turn to receive God's love. As I reflect on today's readings, do I need to widen my acceptance to include those who are seen as outsiders today? As I listen to the readings and reflect on God's love for everyone, how can I strive to accept everyone as Jesus did?

Thus says the Lord: Have a care for justice, act with integrity, for soon my salvation will come and my integrity be manifest.

God never takes back his gifts or revokes his choice.

God has imprisoned all men in their own disobedience only to show mercy to all mankind.
