

The Passion - "Truly this man was God's Son!"

We start this week's readings with Jesus almost crushed by the crowds welcoming Him as their King. As we travel through the readings we see a figure who is increasing alone and isolated. At the end an ordinary Roman soldier proclaims that Jesus is the son of God.



The painting captures that sense of alienation, the cost Jesus bore for us and for the whole world. He entered fully into our humanity and from that place He shows us how to continue to trust in God, Abba, our Father.

The painting also reminds us of the first Eucharist, broken and

given. Jesus' obedience to the point of death reveals our nourishment for the journey and the Father's saving love for all.
