

A path of suffering and blood

Cont...

In this brief review, we can see that the word of God is not a series of abstract ideas but rather a source of comfort and companionship for every family that experiences difficulties or suffering. For it shows them the goal of their journey, when God “will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain any more” (Rev 21:4).

The work of your hands

At the beginning of Psalm 128, the father appears as a labourer who by the work of his hands sustains the physical well-being and tranquillity of his family: “You shall eat the fruit of the labour of your hands; you shall be happy, and it shall be well with you” (Ps 128:2). It is clear from the very first pages of the Bible that work is an essential part of human dignity; there we read that “the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to till it and keep it” (Gen 2:15). Man is presented as a labourer who works the earth, harnesses the forces of nature and produces “the bread of anxious toil” (Ps 127:2), in addition to cultivating his own gifts and talents.

St Benedict's Future Mission Meetings: We had our second meeting on the future mission of St. Benedict's. This time of Community Reflection and Discernment is shaped by Pope Francis' Vision for the Parish to continue to be *'the Church living in the midst of the homes of her sons and daughters'* and in all *'its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelisers'* ie share the faith. (Pope Francis Para 28 Evangelii Gaudium). At our first meeting the top four areas that people wanted to work on in the near future were identified (from the NCLS) broadly as Spiritual Growth, Ministry to Children and Youth, Liturgies that nurture faith, and Building a strong sense of Community. The discussion in these areas was focussed on: What to Keep; What to Try; and What to Change. The Second meeting was working on what to do, how to do it and who would be able to action it. Mission Statements were presented and voted upon and these will go to the parish pastoral council for consideration. A full summary of that meeting will be distributed soon.
