SEASON OF CREATION REFLECTION by Nick Brodie

Scrupulous religious habits can be at odds with God's word. Jesus makes it abundantly clear that being outwardly pious is pointless if we cling to sinful dispositions and routinely harm others. God sees right through our self-deceit.

In making this point, Jesus lists various sins. Most are explicitly the sort that use or hurt individual people and entire communities.

In Laudato Si', his encyclical 'On Care for Our Common Home', Pope Francis quotes the Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew saying that 'to commit a crime against the natural world is a sin against ourselves and a sin against God.'

As we start the Season of Creation we might examine our lives in this light. Have we, in what we have done or failed to do, sinned against what God has made?

True holiness embraces the entire universe. This is why Pope Francis invites us to face the sins of the present by using the world's resources responsibly and equitably. When we next bless ourselves at the Church's door, after making the Sign of the Cross with Holy Water, we could pray for the grace to become a blessing for Creation.


