- The PRIEST is the only Minister of the Eucharist. Lay people who assist with the distribution of holy communion are therefore always called MINISTERS OF COMMUNION (never Eucharist Ministers).
- Priests and deacons are 'Ordinary' ministers of holy communion. Lay ministers who assist with communion are therefore called 'Extra-ordinary'.
- The Church evangelises and is herself evangelised through the beauty of the liturgy, which is both a celebration of the task of evangelisation and the source of her renewed self-giving.

 It is imperative that we respectfully observe silence in Church especially before Mass. People would like to pray in preparation for Mass and it is a MUST that we should all respect that too. Devotions and prayers are greatly appreciated and you are encouraged to continue doing that before Mass. However, you are asked to do your devotions 30 minutes before Mass time so that we have a 10 minute of silence before Mass in preparation at any place and day.
